## Official report JADS council election

In this official report, the outcome and the course of the JADS council election, which has taken place during the period of Monday December 2 until Friday December 6 2024, will be reported. The official report begins with a brief description of the election, followed by the turnout. Furthermore, there will be a report of the results and finally a description of the course of the election. Extra attention is paid to the legality of the votes cast.

### Election details

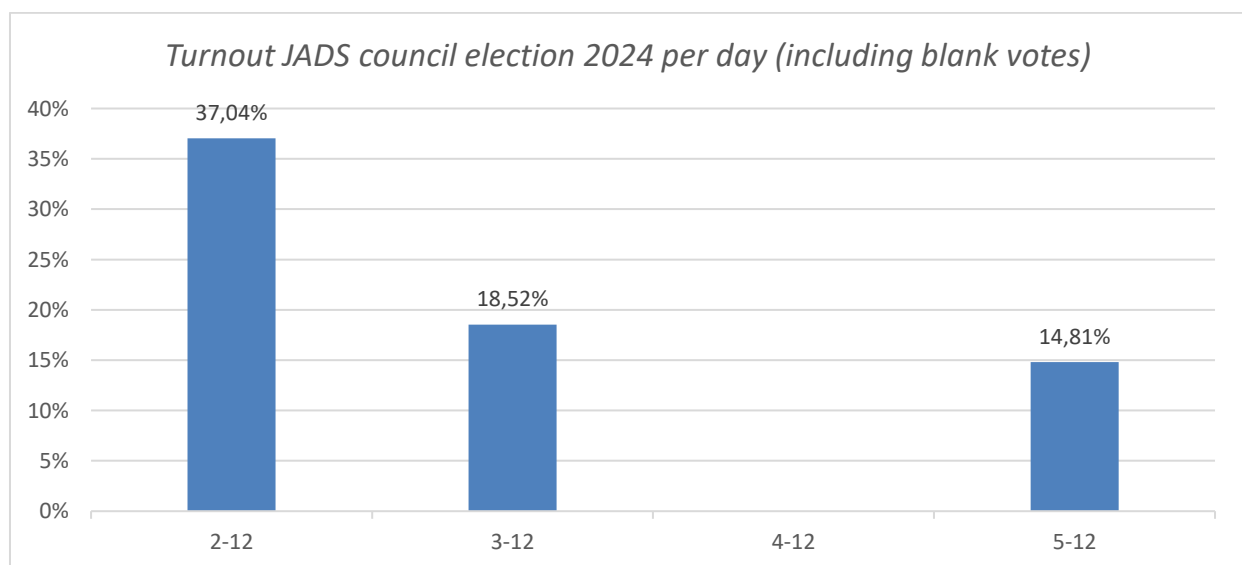
The purpose of the election was to choose 2 new members for the JADS council. In total, there were 3 candidates. Each voter could cast his/her vote on exactly 1 candidate on the ballot. The votes have only been accepted if exactly the right amount of votes were cast. The candidates appeared "at random" on the digital ballot; each time a voter logged in, the order of the candidates automatically changed.

It was also possible to cast a blank vote instead of voting for candidates. They are included in the turnout percentage, but not in the results.

### Election turnout

The table below shows the number of votes cast per candidate. The interpretation of the result is based on the election regulations.

## Course of the election

The election of the JADS council of started Monday December 2 at 10.00 (CET) and ended on Friday December 6 at 12.00 (CET).

On December 2, all voters received an e-mail with a personal and direct link containing a unique login combination, which sent them directly through to the personal digital ballot on: <https://jads.digitaleverkiezing.nl>. This e-mailing verified whether all email addresses were correct and there were no delays in the delivery of the e-mails. According to Inkesta's e-mail system, 1 e-mail has not arrived (bounced). This was communicated to JADS's contact.

During the election period, a reminder has been sent on December 5 at 10.00 (CET) by e-mail to the voters who had not yet voted.

In total, 27 voters have been approached by e-mail. The election were conducted correctly. The turnout of the election was over 70%.

Inkesta monitored the votes cast during in this period, taking a critical look at the origin of the votes (IP addresses) and the development of the number of votes over time. No irregularities were found. All votes cast are therefore valid.
